**Definitions:**

**1. Manufacturer (or Supplier) Name & Address:**

The name and address of the entity that last manufactures, assembles, produces or grows the commodity.

**2. Seller Name & Address:**

The last known seller's (or owner's) name and address at the time of the Security Filing.

- For consigned shipments (e.g. 'to order of') the name and address of the owner or supplier must be provided in lieu of seller's name and address.

**3. Buyer Name & Address:**

The last known buyer's (or owner's) name and address at the time of filing the Security Filing

- For consigned shipments or those instances where there are no buyers, the name and address of the owner or controlling party of the shipment must be provided in lieu of the buyer's name and address.

**4. Ship to Name & Address:**

The name and address of the first "deliver-to" party scheduled to physically receive the goods after Customs release.

**5. Container Stuffing Location:**

The physical foreign location street, city, country, where the goods were stuffed into the container prior to closing of the container.

- When the goods are not containerized, the address(es) of the location(s) where the goods were made ship to ready (palletized/crated) must be provided.

**6. Consolidator Name & Address:**

Foreign receiving party that physically stuffs the container prior to receipt by the carrier shipment to the U.S. If the cargo is stuffed at the point of manufacturer, the name and address of the manufacturer must be provided.

**7. Importer of Record:**

The unique identifying number of the entity primarily responsible for the payment of any duties on the merchandise or an authorized agent acting on his behalf.

- The importer may be any of the following parties; the consignee, the importer of the record, the actual owner of the merchandise, the transferee of the merchandise.

**8. Consignee Number:**

The unique identifying number of the entity to which the goods are to be consigned. Typically, the consignee is he party who has a fiduciary interest in the cargo. This is normally the party defined at the house bill level.

**9. Country of Origin:**

This is the country in which the goods were wholly obtained or produced.

- The country of origin must be provided for all the goods that have been listed as the 6-digit HTS level.

**10. Commodity Harmonized Tariff Schedule Number (6 or 10 digit):**

Indicates the commodity being classified under the U.S. HTS system and /or the Schedule B system to the 6 digit level or to the 10 digit level.
